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## **Incision/Wound Care After Surgery Home Care Instructions**

Mild swelling and pain at incision site can be normal. Pain will decrease as wound heals. Stiches will dissolve in 2-4 weeks.

### **Steri-Strips**

Please keep Steri-Strips in place. They will fall off on their own over the next 2-3 weeks.

### **Bathing**

Please do not get the wound wet for at least 48-72 hours after surgery. Please do not submerge the wound in water for at least one week after surgery. Do not scrub or soak the wound.

### **Antibiotics**

You may be prescribed an antibiotic postoperatively but this is not a requirement. This depends on type of surgery that is performed. Many times, we do not need any antibiotics postoperatively.

### **Activity**

Please wait at least 2 weeks to return to strenuous activities and sports.

### **When to call the doctor**

Call for any of the following signs of infection:

- Yellow or green discharge that is increasing.
- Change in odor of discharge.
- Change in size of incision
- Redness or hardening surrounding the area.
- Incision is hot to the touch.
- Fever.
- Increasing or unusual pain.
- Excessive bleeding.
